Why is this seminar more expensive than the seminar offered at my university?

What do I need to bring to the seminar?

A financial calculator, preferably the HP-12C or HP-17B. A Laptop with Microsoft Excel, PowerPoint and Word, Adobe Acrobat Reader and USB memory stick ability (for file sharing and distribution). Modeling classes are optimized for Office 2007, 2003 and earlier versions. In addition, many of the shortcut keys will not work for MAC operating systems. It is highly recommended that all participants bring a PC to the session as the learning experience is enhanced for PC users.

Where will the seminar be held?
